7. Mail your card!



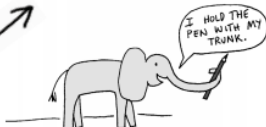

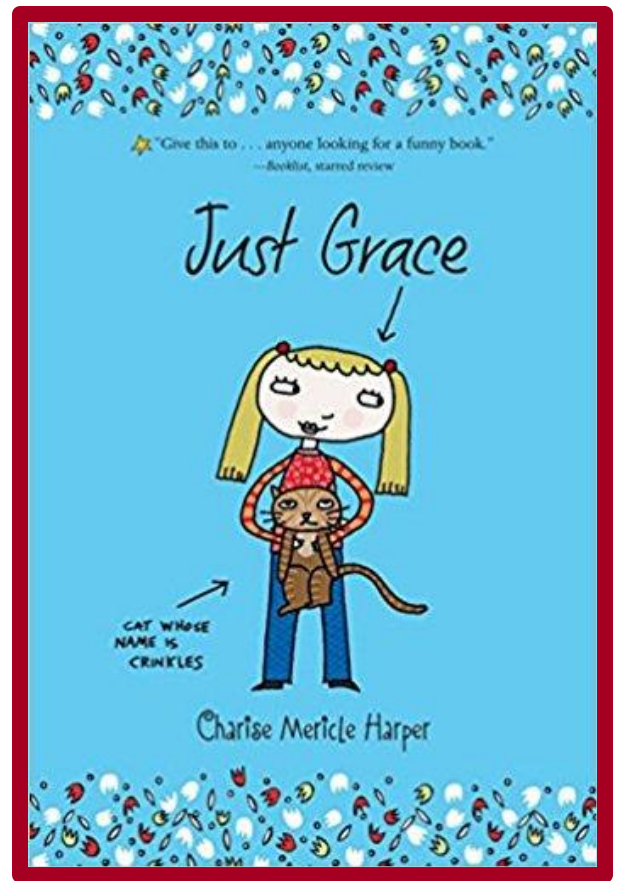
